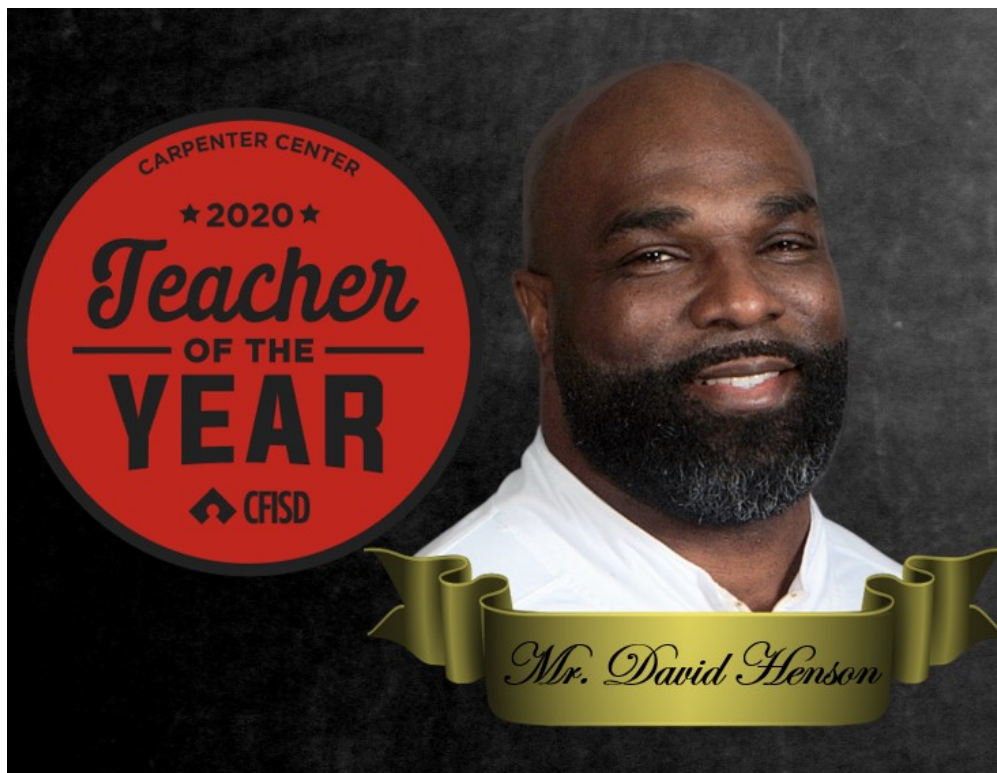
## Teacher of the Year

## Dress Code Updates

Students at The Carpenter Center have a dress code. The following standards are in addition to the dress code guidelines outlined in the CFISD Student Handbook & Code of Conduct.

- Shirts or blouses must be free of any inappropriate content, graphics, innuendos.
- Rips, tears and holes in pants/ shorts/ skirts are not permitted.
- Sagging is strictly prohibited.
- Shorts and skirts must measure no more than 2" above the knee.
- Pullover sweatshirts or sweaters may be worn. Sweaters/ cardigans may be worn, however, if a student removes them, they will put turned in. **Hoodies, jackets, zippered or buttoned outerwear is not permitted.**
- Offensive or gang related tattoos must be covered.
- Students must wear closed-toe shoes to participate in Physical Education.
- Any headwear (hats, hoodies, scarfs, bandanas, etc.) that is not religious based is prohibited.
- Graphics and words on socks must have school appropriate content.
